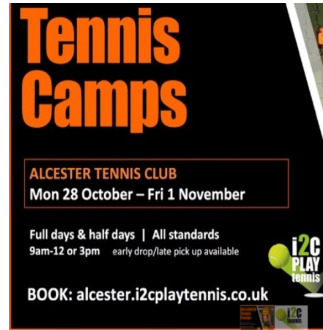
Key Stage Two inter sports afternoon
