Year 6 SATs

What are they designed to test?

- Key Stage 2 tests are National Tests, designed to test pupil knowledge and understanding of the National Curriculum.
- They provide a snapshot of pupil's attainment at the end of the key stage.
- Children will be sitting tests in English and Maths.
- They will be marked externally and returned to school.

The children will sit the following papers.

English:

- Reading
- Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar
- Spelling
- Writing will be subject to teacher assessment and externally moderated across the county

Maths:

- Paper 1 Arithmetic paper
- Paper 2 Reasoning (non calculator)
- Paper 3 Reasoning (non calculator)

The timetable for the week

Date	Activity
Monday 11 May 2020	English grammar, punctuation and spelling papers 1 and 2
Tuesday 12 May 2020	English reading
Wednesday 13 May 2020	Mathematics papers 1 and 2
Thursday 14 May 2020	Mathematics paper 3

How long is each paper ?

English:

- **Reading paper: 1 hour paper. Children will have 3 separate texts to read and then answer a variety of questions**
- **Grammar and Punctuation: 45 minutes to answer a variety of short questions**
- **Spelling: Around 15 minutes (not strictly timed)
Pupils listen to 20 words dictated within 20 sentences**
